

## **Snowflake Wreath Instructions**

## Overview

This project is for adults and children ages 5 and up with adult supervision.

## Materials

Included in this kit: Chipboard wreath form White paint & foam paintbrush Foil snowflakes Plastic snowflakes Glue tabs Glue

## Instructions

- 1. Begin by protecting your work surface with newspaper.
- 2. Using the included white paint and foam paintbrush, paint your wreath form. To avoid warping the cardboard, paint with several thin coats of white paint, allowing each layer to dry thoroughly.
- 3. While your paint dries, separate the included foil snowflakes by color.
- 4. Once the paint is completely dry, begin arranging and gluing your foil snowflakes. Arrange the darkest blue snowflakes evenly around the wreath, gluing as you go. Arrange and glue the rest of the snowflakes in layers from darkest to lightest. Allow the glue to dry.
- 5. Using the provided glue tabs, attach the largest plastic snowflake to the bottom of the wreath. You can use the remaining tabs to attach the medium snowflakes and glue to attach the smallest.
- 6. Allow your wreath to dry at least 24 hours before hanging.
