

Wood Spool Ornament Instructions



Materials

Materials in kit:

- 1-wood spool
- 1-jingle bell (assorted colors)
- Silver ribbon
- Blue ribbon
- Twine

Materials you need:

- Scissors
- Glue

Instructions

- 1. Measure and cut a length of blue ribbon that will wrap entirely around the center of the spool.
- 2. Using either the glue provided or some you have at home, you will put a line of glue along the center of the spool and lay one end of the ribbon on the glue. Allow to dry a bit.
- 3. Once the first line of glue is fairly dry, wrap the remaining ribbon around the center of the spool until the two ends meet or slightly overlap.

- 4. Glue the second end of ribbon to the spool. (Tip: You may need to hold the ribbon in place until the glue has dried a bit.)
- 5. Once your blue ribbon has been glued to the spool, take your silver ribbon and tie a bow around the center of the spool. Adjust your bow to the size you prefer and trim the tails.
- 6. Take your twine and fold it in half. Thread either end through the holes in your spool.
- 7. Adjust your twine so that you will have enough length to later knot the ends but also so you can hang the decoration.
- 8. Once your spool has been threaded, take your jingle bell and thread that on to one of the end pieces of twine.
- 9. Position the bell where you would like it to be on the twine and then knot the two ends of twine. This will prevent your bell and spool from moving.
- 10. To create a more secure ornament, you can also knot the twine at the top of the spool.
- 11. Once you have done these steps, your ornament should look similar to the one in the photo. Enjoy!
