


Tech Topics: Windows 10 Basics

Interface



Desktop – A storage location for files and the main background of your computer

Task Bar – Pin your most frequently used applications to bottom of screen for quick access

Start Menu – Where you configure the settings of your computer

- Shutdown, restart, sign out options
- Manage and customize layout of applications
- Search for applications
- Access settings to customize various features of the computer
 - o Display, printer, WiFi, run updates, uninstall apps, individual user accounts

File Explorer – Where all of your files live

- Storage locations such as desktop, documents, downloads, and pictures are separated into folders
- Several different view options for document icons and information
- You can move files between folders by clicking and dragging
- Create a new folder by right clicking and choosing new>folder

Extra Features

- Microsoft Edge native Windows web browser
- Cortana use speech to search your computer and do internet searches
- Recycling bin delete files off of your computer
- Task View See all of the apps currently open in one view
- Photos app Do basic editing on your pictures
