

Fabric & Twine Mini-Ball Ornament

Overview

This project is for adults and children in second grade and up.

Materials

- 1 ball
- Length of twine
- Piece of fabric

Instructions



2. Gather the fabric around the ball by bringing each of the four corners towards one another. Holding the fabric together by wrapping your thumb and index finger around it works well.



3. Take your twine and wrap it around the fabric, where the top of the ball will be. Tie a knot that will allow you to have plenty of length on either side of the twine. After tying the first knot, continue to wrap the remaining length of twine around the fabric 2 or 3 times and then double knot the twine to prevent it from unraveling. You want to still have enough twine that you can create a loop to hang the ornament from.



4. After tying the double knot, you will have two lengths of twine left. Tie the ends together to create a loop to hang the ornament. Your project is now complete.
